

2019 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

REQUIREMENTS - ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

- Attend a 4-year college/university located in the state of Alabama.
- Be a United States citizen.
- Be a high school senior, graduating in good standing, with a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Have a score in the 50 percentile or above on either the ACT or SAT.
- Have participated in extracurricular activities and/or served in leadership roles in high school, church or community.

Please read and carefully follow these instructions:

- **Submit the entire application with all requirements by MARCH 1, in one envelope, to the John Stallworth Foundation.**
- **Do NOT use certified, overnight or registered mail as this may delay delivery.**
- **Incomplete packages will not be considered.**
- **Include only the items listed below in your package:**
 - (1) **Completed, signed scholarship application form. *Do not leave any blank sections. If a section does not apply to you, write n/a in space provided. (Income/other information provided is subject to verification.)***
 - (2) **Principal and/or counselors report verifying your GPA, your SAT/ACT scores and the percentile of your scores.**
 - (3) **Essay**
 - (4) **Official high school transcript with SAT/ACT scores**
 - (5) **Three letters of recommendation from community leaders, pastor or teachers**
 - (6) **Copy of acceptance letter from the university you plan to attend.**

ESSAY CRITERIA:

- **250 words maximum; type the essay; include your typed name and sign it.**
- **Explain why you need to receive the scholarship.**
- **Outline your career goals, and how you plan to support your university and community after graduation.**

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD INFORMATION:

- The John Stallworth Foundation's academic scholarship **award is based primarily on the financial need** of applicants who meet scholastic achievement, merit, and provide evidence of leadership. The minimum John Stallworth Foundation scholarship award is \$3,500 per year.
- Income information is subject to verification. If you live in a one parent household and receive child financial support, include income pertaining to both parents.
- Funds are disbursed in July for the fall semester, and in December for the spring semester.
- Scholarships may be renewed for up to four years, if recipient meets requirements.
- All information provided in your application is subject to verification.
- If selected for a scholarship, you will be required to sign a scholarship acceptance agreement which outlines requirements for receiving and continuing this scholarship.
